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🏠 Grade-wise Prompts

Grade 1

- Draw or write one way you can save water at school.
- Draw or write how you can take care of a tree or plant.
- Draw or write one way you can keep your classroom clean.

Grade 2

- Draw or write what you should do when you see plastic on the ground.
- Draw or write one way you can help birds, butterflies, or animals.
- Draw or write how you can save electricity at home.

Grade 3

- Draw or write one way to stop wasting food.
- Draw or write one way you can reuse something instead of throwing it away.
- Draw or write how you can protect water, trees, or animals near your school.

Grade 4

- Write one action your family can take to save electricity.
- Write one way you can reduce plastic waste at home.
- Write one action you can take to keep your town clean.

Grade 5

- Write one way to stop wasting food in your school lunch.
- Write one way to save water during dry days.
- Write one action to recycle or reuse something at home.

Grade 6 *Protecting Mangroves & Beaches*

- Write one action to protect mangrove trees.
- Write one step you can take to keep beaches clean.
- Write one way to stop waste from entering rivers or canals.

Grade 7 *Renewable Energy & Saving Power*

- Write one action to save electricity in your school.
- Write one way to promote the use of solar power at home or school.
- Write one idea to reduce energy waste in your community.

Grade 8 *Say No to Single-use Plastics*

- Write one way to say “no” to single-use plastics in daily life.
- Write one action to make your classroom plastic-free.
- Write one way your school can reduce plastic use in the canteen.

Grade 9 *Global Warming & Pollution Control*

- Write one step to reduce air pollution from vehicles.
- Write one way to reduce paper use in your school.
- Write one action to slow down global warming.

Grade 10 *Waste & Recycling*

- Write one idea to reduce electronic waste in your school.
- Write one action to recycle waste properly in your neighborhood.
- Write one way to reuse old school materials (books, uniforms, or papers).

Grade 11 *Protecting Biodiversity & Nature*

- Write one step to protect endangered animals or birds in your area.
- Write one action to save trees or forests in Sri Lanka.
- Write one way to support biodiversity in your community.

Grade 12 *Climate Change & Renewable Energy*

- Write one project idea for students to fight climate change locally.
- Write one action to encourage renewable energy use in schools.
- Write one way to protect rivers, canals, or lakes in your area.

Grade 13 *Youth Leadership & Innovation*

- Write one plan to make Ananda College a plastic-free model school.
- Write one youth-led campaign idea to fight global warming in Sri Lanka.
